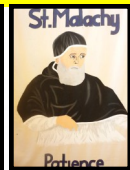

Everyone is invited.

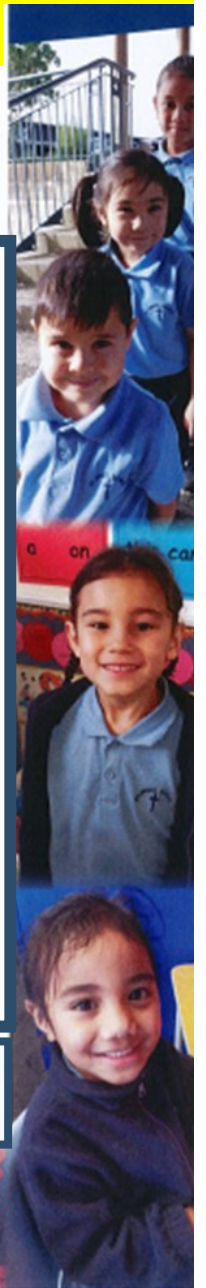
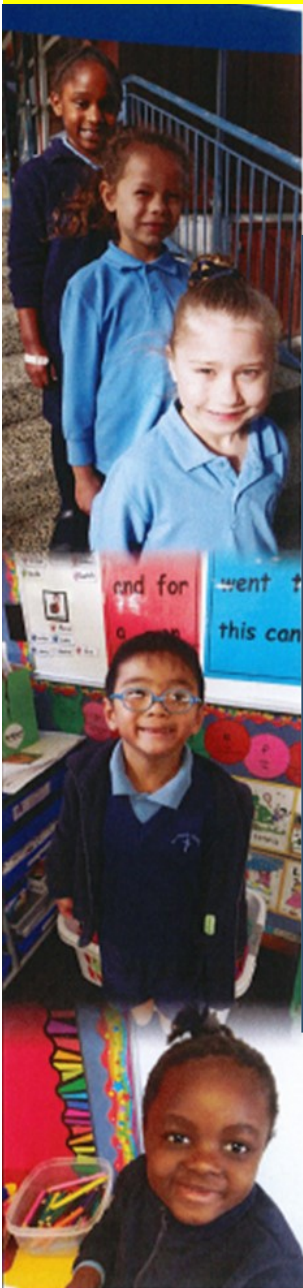

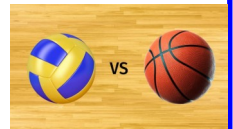
