Olympics

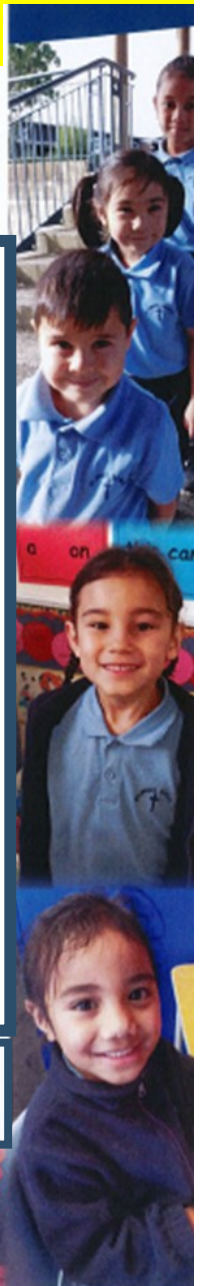
I am always amazed at the skill level, dedication and fitness of our athletes. I am so proud of them even though I do not know them personally. Their efforts are incredible.

Ki te kotahi te kākaho ka whati, ki te kāpuia e kore e whati | A single reed will break, but if it is bunched together it will not.

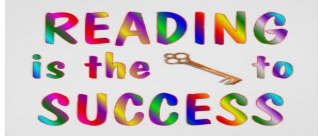
If you see **Mary** in the carpark, make sure to give her a high five or a massive hug and say cheers!
