The school hat costs \$15 and can only be purchased from the Uniform Shop on Friday mornings. You will need to name the hat. Parents and caregivers please ensure that your child has a school hat. This is part of our Uniform and Sun Safe policies.

Car park safety:

As we begin Term Four, with several new students having recently joined our community and more expected soon, car park safety is of utmost importance. Please make sure that you are using car park etiquette, e.g.

- Reverse into car parks
- Parents step out of your car and pick up your children
- Use the pedestrian crossings
- The drive-through is available from 2.55pm
- Pick up all children by 3.10pm or they will be put into After School Care at a cost to you
- Do not use the staff carpark at all.

Student attendance:

Over the next day or so I am sending out attendance information for all parents whose children have less than 90% attendance for 2024. I know that each case is different with some children having gone on holiday and some children being seriously ill, but I feel that all parents need to be aware of their child's attendance and be given accurate information about their child.

In order to understand the information, here are some details. An absence due to illness or medical reasons is considered justified. However, an example of an unjustified is when parents do not provide any information explaining it or the absence does not meet our justified criteria. Also to note, the school has now begun using an 'overseas' category.

The information being sent to you is to help you be aware of the situation in regards to our concerns. The goal is for at least 75% of children to attend 90% of their time at school. While there may be some valid reasons for your child's absence, there are some ways you can avoid keeping children at home. Going to the airport, one child is sick so the sibling stays home, the child is tired are NOT justified reasons for absence.
