Thank you to our Year 6 leaders and our teachers Miss Backhouse-Smith and Mr Canovas for organising the Nuiean Language Day last week. It was great to see so many children take part.

As summer approaches I am taking this opportunity to remind parents that our children need to adhere to the School Uniform Policy. All children must wear the school hat (\$15), not a Kmart or Warehouse hat. The Sunsafe Policy of no hat no play comes into effect on Tuesday 29 October.

If the children are not wearing the school hat they must play under the shelters or go to the library.

The Uniform Policy states that all children wear the correct school uniform and I hope WEAR IT WITH PRIDE. By this I mean that the uniform should be clean and tidy; this includes clean shoes and the correct school socks.

Pleae ensure that all hair is tied back, including our boys with long hair. This practice discourages nits.

In terms of jewellery, the only jewellery permitted is small stud earrings. Children may wear something around their neck but only with permission from me. This could include a small cross or pounamu but only if this is spiritually and culturally significant to the family. This should be seen as St Paul's students are all about humility.
