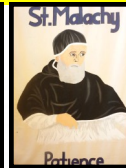

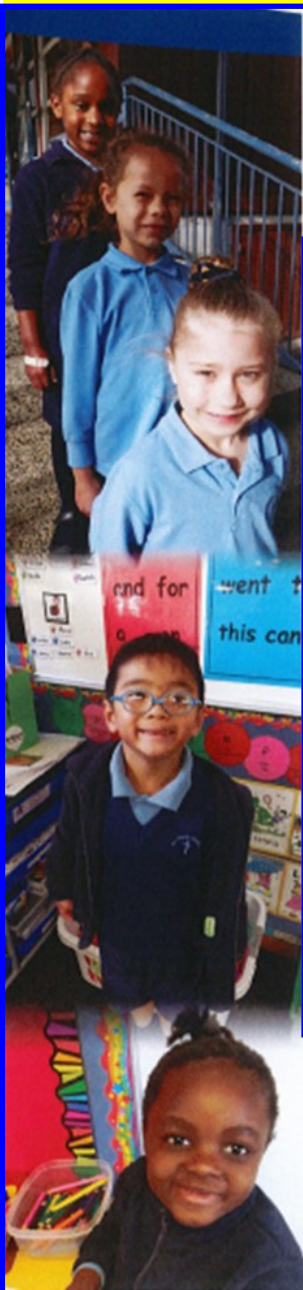
Mission Day

complicated. Their education and health system is totally free and their support for learners is world renowned. The children are in education from birth. Children receive the same education from 1 year old. The system is consistent. There are small class sizes, a high ratio of Teacher Aide support, free lunch every day, and a doctor, nurse, and psychologist available for every school. But the tax rate is very high.

However, the point of me telling you this is that our teachers/kaiako at St Paul's do an amazing job. Our schools are very diverse and our children come to school at the age of 5 with varying degrees of preparation for school. Teachers work hard to ensure that every child achieves success. The way they teach (pedagogy) is very effective as our results show.

So on Friday 1 November remember to thank our teachers for all their hard work.

Parents please continue supporting your child's learning. Make sure that they are doing their homework every day, especially reading every day and learning the mathematical basic facts starting with addition and subtraction, then learning their times tables, including division.
